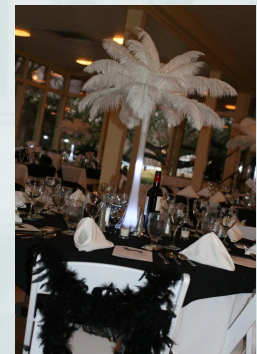

MEADOWS FOUNDATION GRANTS HSUVALDE



The Meadows Foundation granted HSUvalde \$25,000 last year to continue to provide programs in our community to help reduce euthanasia and suffering. Studies have shown that spay/neuter programs, which target low income families, can make a difference in

the euthanasia rate of a community. Through education, HSUvalde hopes to reduce the number of dogs, cats, puppies and kittens going into the shelter and pound, which in turn will reduce euthanasia, as well as pain and suffering caused by overcrowded conditions.

When volunteers did the usual “walk through” of the city pound looking for rescues, this was a dog that was written off as sad but not a possibility for rescue. Jeff & Vicky Nelson, long time foster parents for HSUvalde and advocates of the pit bull breed, felt otherwise. Their hearts were drawn to Mr. Pitiful Miles as they called

him, so they took him home to foster. While putting on weight and getting healthy, Miles also had some basics to learn such as playing with toys and interacting with people and other dogs. The Nelsons brought Miles into their family and treated him like one of their own. In doing so, they taught him about the love and companionship humans can offer and helped him overcome his fear of life. After only a few short months in foster care, Miles was discovered on www.hsu.petfinder.com by a wonderful family in San Angelo. Miles and the family met, and it was an instant match for everyone in-
